<p>Department Duties:</p> <p>ORC 5119.02(H)- <u>May</u> provide training of mentally ill persons if the Department so determines...</p>	<p>Department Duties:</p> <p>ORC 3793.02(A), (B)(2), (B)(3), & (B)(7)- <u>Shall</u> promote, assist in developing & coordinate programs of education & research for prevention of alcohol & drug addiction, prevention of gambling addiction, treatment/ intervention of alcoholics & persons who abuse drugs of abuse, & treatment/intervention of persons with gambling addictions</p>
<p>Support of Community Support System:</p> <p>ORC 5119.06(C) & (M)- <u>Shall</u> provide training, consultation, & technical assistance regarding mental health programs & services & appropriate prevention and mental health promotion activities, including those culturally sensitive...; <u>Shall</u> provide training regarding provision of community-based mental health services to Dept. employees utilized in state-operated community-based mental health services</p>	<p>Education & Training Program for Employees of State Correctional & Youth Services Institutions:</p> <p>ORC 3703.16(B)- <u>Shall</u> develop program designed to educate & train employees of each state correctional institution, employees of each department of youth services institution pursuant to substance abuse treatment or rehabilitation program...</p>
<p>Establishing Physician Recruitment Program:</p> <p>ORC 5119.101(B)- <u>May</u> establish physician recruitment program...</p>	<p>Program Providing Information & Service to Courts:</p> <p>ORC 3793.18- <u>Shall</u> develop & maintain program that continually provides courts with relevant information pertaining to alcohol & drug addiction services and programs...</p>
<p>Conduct Collaborative Training Efforts for Students:</p> <p>ORC 5119.11(A)- <u>May</u> enter into agreement with boards of institutions of higher education or hospitals to establish, manage, & conduct collaborative training efforts for students enrolled in occupations/ professions needed to provide care, treatment for persons receiving mental health services</p>
